What we did in March!



ST MARY MAGDALENE CHURCH AND THE FUTURE

As a parish we need to look to the future and the growth of our worshipping community in the coming years.

The church of St Mary Magdalene, a site of worship for well over 1000 years, has been written about by many visitors over the years and two of these were Ella Pontefract and Marie Hartley. In a publication, "The Charm of Yorkshire Churches" printed in 1936 by the Yorkshire Weekly Post, Ella and Marie's compilation of churches and villages they visited filled this book. They wrote regularly in The Weekly Post, along with sketches of each church visited something Marie excelled at.

St Mary Magdalene Church was one such parish church included in their book. Their writings seem to be of more peaceful times, bird songs, solitude and with our village surrounded by wooded roads. They describe St Mary Magdalene church as 'of one delight after another as they walked through the south doorway with its ball-flower ornament and the stone-roofed porch into the church yard'. Many other descriptions were noted as they toured the church. Their journey also included St Helen's Burghwallis described as "chosen for a Christian settlement in the days of the Roman occupation".

It is our wish that in the next 90 years, way into the future, will we still have a worshipping community active in St Mary Magdalene Campsall. Without funding/donations to maintain, restore and improve this muchadmired parish church, sadly no more modern-day Ella and Marie will be writing about how well-preserved St Mary's Campsall is. Let us all try to prove it can continue!

We are actively looking at ways to achieve our goals and our Restoration Fund is vital to achieving our future needs. Let's look to the future and this significant grade 1 parish church being the jewel in the crown of South Yorkshire!
